- 2. Must be a high school graduate
- 3. Must be a post-secondary student with an agriculture production, precision farming, agronomy, entomology, or Natural Resources as fields of study in a South Dakota College, University or Technical School or any bordering state.

Resource Conservation Speech Contest

Each year the South Dakota Department of Agriculture,
Resource Conservation and Forestry Division sponsors a
resource conservation-oriented speech contest. Any SD
student in grades 9-12 is eligible to enter. This includes public,
private, and home-school students.

The contest consists of three levels – local, area, and state.
Two winners from each of the local contests advance to area contests. Two winners from each of the seven area contests advance to the state competition.

- First Place: \$1,200 Scholarship
- Second Place: \$800 Scholarship
- Third Place: \$500 Scholarship

<u>South Dakota Firefighters Association (SDFA):</u> Fire Service Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY:

- A Son or Daughter of any member (living, deceased or retired) of a Fire Department in South Dakota or an active member of a Junior/Explorer/Cadet Fire Program in South Dakota.
- A high school senior or student entering their first semester of college.
- The applicant must be sponsored by a Fire Department that has 100% Department Membership in the SD Firefighters Association for the current year and dues must have been paid prior to submission of your application.
- The applicant may also be sponsored by a member of the SD Firefighters Auxiliary, a local Fire Department Auxiliary or a member of the Dear Old Timers.
- The scholarship may be used at any University, College or Post-Secondary Institution (Vo-Tech.) Preference will be given to those who are obtaining a Fire Science or Emergency Service degree.
- Applications must be received by the date listed above to be considered.

SD Association of Conservation Districts (SDACDE) Memorial Scholarship

Qualifications:

- The recipient will be a current year graduate of a South Dakota High School.
- The recipient shall have graduated in the upper 50% of the class.
- Students must be attending a school in an Agricultural/Conservation-related field in a South Dakota College or Vocational School.

Selection criteria:

- 1. Personal (employment, extracurricular, honors, community service) = 40%
- 2. Brief description of education and career goals = 30%
- 3. Academic (grades & class rank) = 10%
- 4. Letters of recommendation (2) = 10%
- 5. Financial Need = 10%

The SDACDE is offering three (3) - \$500 scholarships. The purpose of this scholarship is to encourage those students concerned with conserving their natural resources by furthering their education in an agricultural/conservation-related field. The scholarship is available to graduating high school seniors who will be attending a 4-year college or vocational school.
