#### <u> Alert College Scholarship - \$500 Essay Contest</u>

You can help others become more alert by speaking out against the dangers of drug and alcohol abuse. All eligible high school seniors may enter the essay contest.

Eligibility:

- Must be a senior in high school
- Your high school must be located in one of the following states: Alaska, Colorado, Idaho, Minnesota, Montana, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Washington or Wyoming
- You must have a GPA of 2.5 or better
- You must have plans to attend college after graduation

ESSAY:

Write an essay about a personal encounter you or someone you know has had with drug and/or alcohol abuse. In your essay explain how the situation was dealt with, waht you learned from it, what others can learn from the experience, and what was right or wrong (in your opinion) about the way the incident or problem was handled.

• Essays must be typed, double spaced, and 650-800 words in length.

Include an official copy of your high school transcript.

- Must also include a recent photo.
- There is no deadline.

## Dakota Corps Scholarship

### NOW OPEN!

This scholarship is designed to support outstanding student who are committed to pursuing higher education in South Dakota and remaining in the state to work in a Critical Need Area.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

- Graduate from an accredited South Dakota high school with a Grade Point Average (GPA of) 2.8 or greater on a 4.0 scale. Home schooled students will be allowed to provide supplemental information if this requirement is not applicable.
- Have a composite ACT score of 27 or greater (or the SAT equivalent).
- Agree, in writing, to stay in South Dakota and work in a critical need occupation after graduation for as many years as the scholarship was received, plus one year. The current critical need occupations for 2025-26 are:
- Teaching -- K-12
- Teaching -- Secondary
- Special Education
- Foreign LanguageVocal or Instrumental Music
- English as a Second Language (ESL) or English Language Learners (ELL)
- Math
- Science
- Language Arts
- Career and Technical Education

Accountant / Auditor

Engineer: (all areas EXCEPT: mining, chemical, biomedical, and computer hardware)

Information Technology

Registered Nurse

- Apply for the Dakota Corps Scholarship for a school period that begins within one year of high school graduation, or within one year of release from active duty of an active component of the armed forces.
- Attend a participating South Dakota college as an undergraduate student in a program that will prepare the student to work in a critical need occupation.
- Be a U.S. citizen or U.S. national.

#### How to Apply:

- Complete the online application for the Dakota Corps Scholarship 2025-2026 at <u>www.sdbor.edu/applyforscholarships</u>
  - Students who have taken Dual Credit Coursework through a BOR institution can log in using the BOR Student Button under the photo on the left.
- Other students can create a manual account and apply using the Non-BOR Student button under the photo on the right.
- Submit the following documents:
  - High School Transcript
  - ACT Score Documentation

Deadline: All applications must be submitted by December 15, 2024.
