YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS

The Law requires us to release the directory information of our juniors and seniors to all branches of the military. The legislation allows parents and students to request to have their name withheld from those directory lists. We are required by law to notify you of this option. If you choose to have your name removed, watch for an email survey coming soon.

Federal Student Aid 411: Types of Aid

- Grants money you do NOT have to repay YAY! (unless you withdraw from school)
- Scholarships FREE MONEY!! Apply for lots and lots. FREE! FREE! FREE!
- Loans money you borrow and MUST pay back with interest. (Stay tuned for more discussion regarding Federal Student Loans, Parent Plus Loans, and Personal Loans)

Once you complete the FAFSA (available December 1, 2024), you have officially applied for Federal Financial Aid. You have to do this yearly (have your previous years' tax return nearby while completing the application).

As the school year goes along, be sure to check your newsletters. I will be providing more information about Financial Aid to help you understand the process, options, and requirements.

University Specific Scholarships

South Dakota Association of Plumbing-Heating-Cooling Contractors Educational Foundation Scholarship

The purpose of the South Dakota Association of Plumbing-Heating-Cooling Contractors (SDAPHCC) Educational Foundation scholarship is to help individuals prepare for careers in the plumbing, heating, and cooling industry. This scholarship is particularly intended for students enrolled in trade related training programs in the state of South Dakota.

Two scholarships in the amount of \$2000 will be available for award each year.

Applicants should be planning to seek a career in the plumbing, heating, and cooling industry.

- Graduating high school seniors and non-traditional individuals are encouraged to apply.
- Part-time studies will be considered if applicant can show good cause for other than full-time studies.
- Preference will be given to those intending to or who are enrolled in a South Dakota based training program and who will incur out of pocket expenses for said program.
- Recipients are eligible to apply a second time for a subsequent training period. No more than two awards per person.

A letter of application to the SDAPHCC Educational Foundation including the following information is required for consideration.

- · Applicant's contact information
- A typewritten paragraph sharing your career goals
- A sponsorship letter from a member in good standing of the SDAPHCC
- A letter of recommendation from a person that is influential in your life
- Brief description of work history (as appropriate)
- Grade transcripts if a current student

Letter of application and supporting documents must be received at the SDAPHCC office by the 1st of April and may be submitted in person, by mail or electronically.

2024 SD Angus Association Undergraduate Scholarship

The SD Angus Association offers two general scholarships to students pursuing undergraduate degree. To be eligible, applicant must be a high school senior in South Dakota with extracurricular activity involvement including: academics, extra curricular- clubs, honors, community service, employments, sports, etc, involvement in Junior Angus, 4H, FFA or other agricultural organizations, and show financial need. Include with the application packet a color picture and high school transcript. Applications must be postmarked by OCTOBER 31. Applications are located in the counselor's office or online **HERE**

2024 SD Heifer Grant Application

You must be an SD Junior Angus member and a South Dakota resident to be eligible for a grant. If you are not a current member of the SD Junior Angus Association you may join by enclosing your annual membership fee of \$10 made payable to the SD Jr. Angus Association and include it with this application.

Applications can be printed <u>HERE</u> or picked up in the counseling office.

Deadline: October 31.

US JCI Senate Foundation Scholarship

Each year the SD JCI Senate organization awards scholarships to graduating high school seniors who plan to continue their education at an accredited post-secondary college, university or vocational school.

Winning applications will be forwarded to the US JCI Senate Foundation scholarship program for further judging. Foundation scholarship awards are up to \$1500.00.

FAFSA Document Checklist:

- Your Social Security Card and Driver's License and/or alien registration card if you are not a US citizen
- Your 2023 Federal Income Tax Returns, W-2's, and other records of money earned. (The <u>IRS Data Retrieval Tool</u> can help you transfer your federal tax return information right into your FAFSA form.)
- Records and documentation of other nontaxable income received such as welfare benefits, Social Security income, veteran's benefits, military or clergy allowances (if applicable).
- Any additional applicable financial information, such as taxable work-study, assistantships, fellowships, grants, and scholarship aid reported to the IRS, combat pay or special combat pay, and cooperative education program earnings.
- Records of any additional nontaxable income: Examples include child support received, veterans' non-education benefits, money received or paid on your behalf, et.
- Current bank and brokerage account statements, including records of stocks, bonds, mutual funds, and other investments (if applicable).
- Business or investment farm records (if applicable).
- Records relating to any unusual family financial circumstances.
- Title IV Institution Codes for each school you are applying to. Find HERE
- FSA ID

If you are applying as a dependent - again, you are a dependent unless declared otherwise - one parent is required to sign as well. To electronically fill out your FAFSA online, your parent should apply for a FAFSA ID at the same site.
