"Serving Others" Scholarship

Students applying should choose their local "super citizen" and write a short essay. This should be an individual, business, public servant, nonprofit, etc. who volunteers their time, donates or otherwise is selfless in their support to their community.

Essay and cover letter must be dropped off IN PERSON before February 28.

Requirements:

- Permanent resident of SD
- Attending an accredited South Dakota University
- Full-time in the Fall of 2025
- Drop off application at IIASD member office: 1507 Dakota Ave S in Huron

<u>Coaches Against Cancer Scholarship</u> a South Dakota High School Coaches Assoc. Scholarship ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be or have been a high school student-athlete of an accredited South Dakota high school who has had some medical issues or a family member has had some type of medical issues that may have affected them during their high school career. 2. The scholarship winner must attend an accredited institution of higher education.

Coach Russ Morrell Memorial Scholarship

Applicants for this scholarship must:

- graduate from a South Dakota high school
- attain a minimum GPA of 3.2 through 7 semesters of high school
- submit a SINGLE document (multi-;age but as one attachment ONLY) with:
 - o cover letter
 - o contact information of TWO character references
 - a list of extra-curricular and community service activities
 - a 300 to 500-word essay.

First Dakota Scholarship

- Must be a US citizen/permanent resident
- must be a high school senior or currently attending a post-secondary accredited college or technical school
- Must provide confirmation of enrollment
- At the time of application, student MUST have a First Dakota checking account

Deadline: March 4

Editable applications available <u>HERE</u> or hard copy in the counselors' office.

WRCA Foundation Scholarship (Working Rach Cowboys Assoc.)

- Must be a working ranch cowboy or the son, daughter, or spouse of a working ranch cowboy. A "working ranch cowboy" is defined as any person deriving a significant portion of his/her income from taking care of cattle on a cattle ranch. Day workers are included.
- Must be a high school senior with minimum GPA of 3.00.
- Each recipient must be enrolled as a fulltime student and maintain a GPA of 3.00 for the scholarship to be retained.

<u>South Dakota Coaches Foundation Scholarship</u> a South Dakota High School Coaches Assoc. Scholarship

- evidence of acceptance to post-secondary school


